



SEYDN Hub Funding Awards 2010-11

Hampshire, Berkshire, IOW, Southampton and Portsmouth:

- **Wildern School:** awarded £570 to create a new dance theatre piece for Dub Youth Dance Company
- **Hamble School Sports Partnership:** awarded £500 to develop a GCSE Dance Network for local secondary schools
- **Fuzzy Logic Dance Company and Hamble School Sports Partnership:** awarded £1,050 for a range of boys dance activities across Hamble School Sports Partnership

Oxfordshire, Buckinghamshire and Milton Keynes:

- **Chiltern District Council:** awarded £980 for a performance platform for disengaged young people
- **Oxford City Council:** awarded £1,000 for *Move It Oxford*
- **Bucks New University:** awarded £650 for schools workshops as part of the *Rhythm of Sport* project
