



## SEYDN Hub Funding Awards 2009-10

### SEYDN Hub for Oxfordshire, Buckinghamshire and Milton Keynes:

**Thames Valley Partnership** has been awarded £1,187 for the Transit project in South Buckinghamshire which will provide contemporary dance training for young people at risk.

**West Oxfordshire Youth Dance Development Group** has been awarded £1,800 for Creative Connections, a pilot dance programme for young people in Carterton.

**Dance for Life** has been awarded £519 for a new youth performance event in Buckinghamshire.

### SEYDN Hub for Surrey and West Sussex:

**SB Dance** has been awarded £1,200 to set up Naach Youth Dance Company for young people aged 11-18 years in Cranleigh.

**Woking Dance Festival** has been awarded £1,500 for a boys dance residency with Brahim Bouchelaghem and workshops for young people from West Sussex and Surrey with Yael Flexer and Laila Diallo.

### SEYDN Hub for Hampshire, Southampton, Portsmouth, Isle of Wight and Berkshire:

**Wildern School** has been awarded £450 to establish a dance company for young people aged 12-15 in Hedge End.

**Dance Africa** has been awarded £815 for the Celebrate Africa performance event in Havant.

**Newbury Contemporary Youth Dance Company** has been awarded £1,530 for a choreographic project with Udifydance Company.

**Hamble School Sports Partnership** has been awarded £300 for a GCSE dance network group.

### SEYDN Hub for Kent, Medway, East Sussex and Brighton & Hove:

**3ddance and Mid Kent and Ashford School Sports Partnership** have been awarded £660 for an after-school dance club at Wyvern Special School.

**Brighton and Hove Youth Dance Company** have been awarded £1,100 for a workshop programme in local schools.

**Canterbury Christchurch University** has been awarded £500 for the Improving Health and Fitness Through Dance project with local schools.
